POOL RULES

- 1. Parents/Guardians are responsible for the safety and behavior of their children and guests.
- 2. No Running.
- 3. No Thongs or G-Strings.
- 4. No hanging on lane lines.
- 5. No food or beverage in pools or hot tub.
- 6. No rafts, inner tubes or body boards.
- 7. Parents/Guardians must supervise their children at all times.
- 8. Shower with soap and water before entering the pools or hot tub.
- 9. Adults have priority for the use of lounge chairs over children.
- 10. Boisterous conduct is not permitted in or around the pool. This includes running, pushing, dunking or other acts that would disturb the peace or endanger others.
- 11. Club kickboards are for lap swimmers and swim instruction only.
- 12. Children should not be changed or dressed on the pool deck.
- 13. Children who still require diapers are permitted in the main pool only if they are wearing approved "swimsuit diapers."
- 14. Children under 6 must always have an adult in the water with them.
- 15. Children under the age of 10 must be accompanied and supervised by a person 18 years of age or older while in the main pool areas.
- 16. Children 12 years of age or younger must have an adult in the Athletic Center building or yard while they are swimming.
- 17. The wading pool is reserved only for those children 5 years of age and younger, children must be accompanied by a parent/guardian while in the wading pool.

HOT TUB RULES

- 1. The hot tub is a "Quiet Area" and no swimming or playing in the hot tub is permitted. Toys, flotation devices, kick boards, etc. are not permitted in the hot tub.
- 2. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult when using the hot tub.
- 3. The use of these facilities is not recommended for those under the influence of alcohol, on medication or with high blood pressure or heart conditions.
- 4. The emergency shut-off button must be kept clear.

THE STAFF WILL HAVE COMPLETE AUTHORITY TO ENFORCE RULES AND TO TAKE WHATEVER STEPS ARE NECESSARY TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF THOSE AT THE POOL. THE ATHLETIC CENTER STAFF HAS THE AUTHORITY TO SUSPEND MEMBER'S POOL PRIVILEGES DUE TO MISCONDUCT ON THE DAY OF THE INFRACTION.
